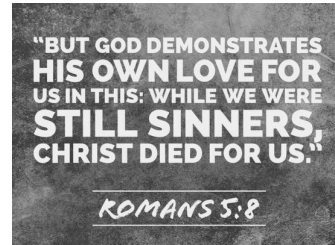


# Weekly Reflection
